Resort Overview:

Nestled along the dramatic Kohala Coast and in the piko, or center, of five great mountains, Mauna Lani is a sacred oasis where generations of families and friends have made memories together on soulful lands once cherished by the greatest of Hawaiian royalty. Greet the morning sun as it rises above the mountains' peaks from the seat of an outrigger canoe. Talk story with friends old and new at the Great Lawn as the sounds of ocean waves and laughter mingle. Dine amongst the company of loved ones at CanoeHouse, where locals have savored the island's bounty for decades. As you walk this storied coastline, breathe the rejuvenating salt air and swim in the crystalline waters, you feel the same mana, or spiritual energy, that first captivated legends like King Kamehameha I and Francis H. I'i Brown.

POOLS AND BEACH:

The subtle smell of sea breeze greets you from the verdant Great Lawn, where prime views of the Resort, Adult and Keiki pools are set amidst a picturesque backdrop painted with sunny skies and seascapes once admired by the greatest of Hawaiian royalty. Dotted with turquoise umbrellas and whispering palms, Mauna Lani's crescent of sandy shore hugs the expansive Pacific Ocean, where mornings begin with sunrise canoe paddles and evenings conclude with sunset swims. An ancient symbol of purity and wealth, water carries innumerable benefits for the mind, body and soul – treat yourself and come on in.

Resort Pool

Joyful sounds of laughter emanate from Mauna Lani's Resort Pool, a 3,900-square-foot, fun-filled haven boasting an unobstructed vantage point of the sea's seemingly endless horizon. Laze the day away along the water's edge, splash around with the whole family or enjoy the simple pleasures of island time from the hot tub.

Adult Pool

Serene bliss is manifested in Mauna Lani's 2,000-square-foot Adult Pool, a quiet sanctuary bordered by plush lounge chairs and swaying palms. Sip on a Lani Tai from nearby Hā Bar and Grill as you gaze at the tranquil fishponds of Kalāhuipua'a, idling the day away in seaside heaven.

Keiki Pool

A keiki-only retreat surrounded by grassy lawns and the nearby Surf Shack, the Keiki Pool is an ideal hangout for little ones. Splash around with new friends, play a game of tag on the expansive Great Lawn, or join Holoholo Kids Crew for a day of sun, sand and smiles.

RESORT BEACH

Soft sand meets tranquil waters at Mauna Lani's Resort Beach, where carefree and blissful moments transpire along the dramatic Kohala Coast. Chase the tides as they kiss the shore, dipping your toes in the Pacific as you survey the water's surface for Honu (sea turtles) and Koholā (humpback whales). Grab your snorkel gear at the Surf Shack and dive into the crystal clear waters of Mauna Lani's swimmable lagoon, exploring the colorful reefs and tropical fish that lie beneath the surface. Surf your first wave with the help of our Kainalu Pros, or sit back, relax and savor the priceless joys of island time.

HOUSE OF KNOWLEDGE

Talk story with Mauna Lani's dear Kahu Hānai, Danny Akaka, about Pele, the Hawaiian Goddess of Fire, or try your hand at the ukulele. String your own lei as the scents of puakenikeni are carried with the trade winds, or simply observe the everlasting beauty of Hawai'i through its symbols and stories.

TURTLE TALK

For more than thirty years, Mauna Lani has raised and nurtured hundreds of green sea turtles in partnership with Oahu-based marine and wildlife center, Sea Life Park, on the contingency of education and conservation. Listen as the end of the Honu Pond as self-proclaimed "turtle man," Pi'i La'e'ha, conveys the environmental, historical and cultural importance of Green sea turtles in Hawai'i.
