Safari Experience

Day 1 Nairobi

On arrival at Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, go through the Customs and Immigration procedures. After clearing customs and immigration formalities, you will be met by a Liberty Africa Safaris representative and transferred to your Nairobi Hotel.

This 45-suite boutique hotel elevates the standard of luxury for travelers in the region. Beautiful in its symmetry and flooded with natural light, this plantation-style property is airy and spacious. Each of our 80m² suites have a private balcony overlooking the iconic silhouette of the Ngong Hills, a magical view which can also be enjoyed over sundowners at the Bar.

Day 2 Masai Mara

After breakfast transfer to Wilson airport for your scheduled flight to the Masai Mara National Reserve departing at 10:30hrs arriving at 11:10hrs. Met on arrival at the airstrip by your camp driver guide and transfer to your camp. Lunch at the camp. After noon on activities that the camp has to offer.

Experience unspoiled eastern Africa up close and personal at the "Instinct of the Mara" lodge. Hidden away in a corner of Olderkesi Conservancy the camp celebrates the true luxury of privacy and endless possibilities. Here, the magical "Out of Africa" feeling is ever-present. Embedded in the untouched nature of the 7,600-acre conservancy in the secluded southeast of the Maasai Mara, you enjoy unforgettable safaris in one of the most beautiful and animal-rich areas of Kenya. On game drives you will encounter antelope, buffalo, zebra, wildebeest, giraffe, elephant, rhino, lion, leopard, and cheetah.

Day 3 and 4 Masai Mara

Day spent game-viewing in the reserve. With morning and afternoon game drives, you have ample time to discover all that this globally famous wilderness has to offer. A pristine wilderness of haunting beauty, it promises its visitors a profusion of wildlife, prolific bird life and the unprecedented opportunity of catching up with all the members of the 'Big Five' in one morning!

Day 5 Masai Mara - Tsavo West

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the local airstrip for your flight to Tsavo West National Park (Mombasa Air departing at 11:30hrs arriving at 12:30hrs). You will be met upon arrival by your camp driver guide and transfer to Kipalo in time for lunch. Afternoon on activities offered by the camp.

The place you return to again and again ". This is what Kipalo means in the language of the Taitas, the tribe living in the region. No wonder – the view from the slopes of the Mbulia Hills over the vast plains of Tsavo and the Ngulia Hills to the majestic Mt. Kilimanjaro is simply breathtaking and awakens a feeling of infinite freedom. If you are looking for seclusion, privacy and unforgettable encounters with Kenya's unique wildlife, then Kipalo Hills is the place for you. The camp, which nestles perfectly against the rocky hillside, was established on the grounds of the Mbulia Group Ranch, which covers almost 36,000 acres, on the initiative of the local people.

Day 6 and 7 Tsavo West

Day spent exploring Tsavo West National Park which achieved notoriety in the 1900's when 'the Man-eaters of Tsavo', a pair of rogue man-eating lions, preyed gruesomely on the builders of the Uganda Railway. Today the Park is more famous for the numerous prides of mane-less lion that patrol the plains and police the herbivore herd. Other wildlife highlights – vast herds of dust-red elephant, fat pods of hippo, giant crocodile, teeming herds of plains game, a fantasia of bird life and some magical flora.

All meals and overnight at Kipalo Hills LDBB (Drinks Included)

Day 8 Mombasa North

After breakfast, transfer by road to Voi for a train ride to Mombasa (Mariakani Station) where you will be met by a Liberty representative and transferred to your hotel on the North Coast, a paradise of sand and bright blue sea. The Kenyan coast offers a colorful history. From the 9th century onwards, Indian, and Arab traders mingled with the indigenous population to create the unique Swahili culture, much of which still survives until this day. The remains of many early Swahili settlements dot the coastline, the most significant being the 15th century Gedi ruins south of Malindi, while Lamu town has been designated a World Heritage Site due to its significance as a Swahili Centre. The coast also boasts unique and diverse habitats, both in maritime and terrestrial national parks and reserves. Highlights include Mombasa Old Town, Lamu, Gedi among others.

Lunch, Dinner and overnight at Cardamom House LDBB (Drinks Included)

Day 9 & 10 Mombasa North

Days spent at your leisure.
