The Grand Cypress Golf Club at the Hyatt Regency Grand Cypress Resort in Orlando offers a premier golfing experience with two distinct 18-hole courses designed by Jack Nicklaus:

The Links Course

This course is Nicklaus's tribute to the famed Old Course at St. Andrews, Scotland. It features open meadows, pot bunkers, and rolling terrain, providing a challenging links-style experience. The course measures 6,773 yards from the back tees, with a par of 72, a slope of 121, and a rating of 71.9.

The Cypress Course

In contrast, the Cypress Course offers a traditional Florida parkland-style layout with lush fairways, shimmering lakes, and bright white bunkers. It provides a scenic and strategic golfing experience.
