PADDLESPO RTS

GOLF

TURTLE TALK

For more than thirty years, Mauna Lani has raised and nurtured hundreds of green sea turtles in partnership with Oahu-based marine and wildlife center, Sea Life Park, on the contingency of education and conservation. Listen as the end of the Honu Pond as self-proclaimed "turtle man," Pi'i La'eha, conveys the environmental, historical and cultural importance of Green sea turtles in Hawai'i.
